The Children's University is a national organisation offering children aged 7-14 an exciting and innovative programme of high quality learning opportunities outside of school hours with a focus on rewarding participation and encouraging engagement with learning.

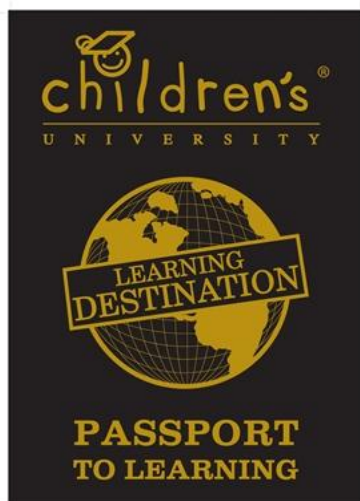
Pupil involvement is recognised in all areas of participation and rewarded through a national certificate scheme. This is based on the number of hours of attendance throughout the year. Pupils are awarded a Bronze (30 hours), Silver (65 hours) and Gold (100 hours) for Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctorate levels.

Accredited hours take place after school at weekends and during school holidays. This learning provision can be in any subject, which can be studied as part of a degree programme such as Marketing, Leadership and Management, and Photography, and has a UCAS code.

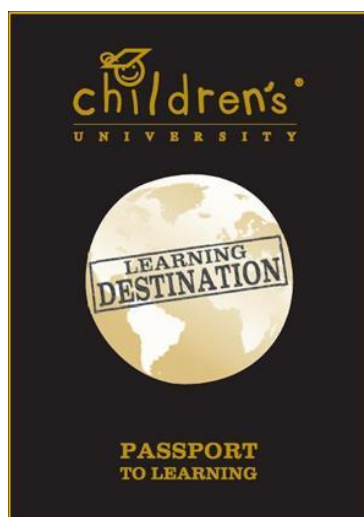
Passport to Learning

Pupils will be able to record their own journey to independent learning through their Passport to Learning, which is an individual record of activities they have participated in. Pupils collect 'stamps' and hours of accredited learning which contributes to the award of their national certificates.



Learning Destinations

Learning Destinations are places and organisations to which children can 'travel' independently with their Passport to Learning. A Learning Destination can range from a museum to a farm or a university as long as the learning centre has been validated by the Children's University and has the official logo. The Passport keeps a record of the validated learning activities within each Learning Destination that the pupil has participated in. This contributes to the pupil's record of achievements and Children's University certification.
