Platanos College has been nationally recognised for its exceptional 2016 performance by the SSAT (the Schools, Students and Teachers network).

Each year the in-depth data analysis by the SSAT combines three official Department for Education (DfE) and Ofsted sources to provide key performance data on all schools across the country. As a result, it has shown that Platanos College is in the **top 10% nationally for progress made by pupils** and **top 20% nationally for pupil attainment**. Additionally, the college has received an award for its success in achieving high levels of performance for pupils eligible for the pupil premium.
