Guest Speaker Dame Sharon White

The Sixth Form students were honoured to host a talk by Dame Sharon White on Thursday 20th October. Dame Sharon spoke in depth about her early education, her studies at Sixth Form and the journey that led her to study at Cambridge University. The students found her talk engaging and inspiring. She spoke about the difficulties that can be faced by pupils wishing to study at a top university such as Cambridge; her advice however was to persist and never give up. Dame Sharon spoke about her illustrious career in the civil service and her current role as Chair of John Lewis. Students asked insightful questions during the Q and A session; Yaqoob Hussain asked if Dame Sharon had any role models that inspired her, she responded that while she doesn't have a 'role model' necessarily, there are people who inspire her. One inspirational character mentioned was Michelle Obama; it was the former First Lady's character and attitude whilst in a high office that Dame Sharon spoke of as being inspirational.
